

Dates and deadlines in the computer science degree programs in the summer semester 2025

Dates and deadlines

- **Registration of study achievements (coursework):** from 01.04.2025 until 22.09.2025 at the latest (via unisono). **As long as you are not registered for the coursework, you cannot and may not submit any work** (e.g. homework, internship assignments, etc.)! Please check the module descriptions (see [website](#)) to see in which modules you must complete coursework.
- **Submission of mentor approvals** for core, elective and compulsory elective subjects according to **PO 2012: by July 07, 2025** (apply to the mentor by e-mail in good time beforehand)
- **Registration for written examinations: from 02.06.2025 to 14 days before the examination** (via unisono; the deadline is calculated to the exact time!)
- **Registration for oral examinations: up to 7 days before the examination** (via unisono; then make an appointment with the examiner, so it is better to register much earlier)
- **Cancellations of examinations without notification of illness: up to 7 days before the examination** (via unisono; the deadline is calculated to the exact time!)
- **Notification of illness for examinations: up to three working days (PO 2012: five working days) after the examination.** The [withdrawal form](#) must be sent to the Examination Office in writing or by e-mail (PDF) together with a medical certificate. If submitted by post, the date of the postmark applies.

It is **always necessary to register for coursework and examinations in good time**, even if you have already registered for the course! If your registration is successful, you will automatically receive a notification via the unisono system. If your registration is unsuccessful, please contact the Examinations Office **immediately**.

The deadlines mentioned are **hard**; registration after the deadline is only possible **in justified cases of hardship!**

Please note different deadlines if the examinations are organized by other departments or faculties. Information on this can be found at the responsible examination office of the respective department/faculty.

Bachelor Computer Science students of the **FPO 2021** can only register for examinations in a specialization module if they have already **bindingly chosen a specialization in unisono**, students after PO 2012 only after submitting a corresponding mentor approval.

- Please note the organizational information in sections 8 and 6 of the **course brochure** for the [Bachelor's](#) and [Master's degree courses in Computer Science](#). There you will find, among other things, information on unisono, study and examination achievements, repetitions, free attempts, final theses, additional required examinations, etc.

- If a required **examination prerequisite** has not yet been entered in unisono when you register for an examination, you cannot register for the examination. Students according to PO 2012 may be conditionally admitted by unisono but may only take the examination if they have successfully completed the examination prerequisite by the date of the examination. If you are unable to complete the examination prerequisite by then, please deregister from the examination immediately.
- If you do not wish to take a registered course or examination in a semester, please deregister as early as possible.
Coursework and examinations must be deregistered up to 8 days before the end of the semester, as you can no longer deregister from examinations in the last week of the semester. If you are still registered, the examiner will mark you as a "no-show" (i.e. grade 5.0).
Deregistration after these hard deadlines is only possible in cases of hardship!
- **Project work** (in the Master's degree course) runs over two semesters. You register for the course in the semester in which the project work starts. You will be informed **by the lecturer** in the first or second semester if you can register for the coursework. In the second semester, you will be informed **by the lecturer** when you can register for the examination.
